



Workshop outline

Introduction

By exploring a fictitious incident on the road, this course will investigate the key rationale and reasoning as to why it occurred and what could have been done to prevent it.

The course will cover a number of subjects including:

Awareness, anticipation and planning

Speeding vs inappropriate speed

Impairment through drink and drugs

Distractions

Factors affecting collisions: the driver, the vehicle, the road

Consequences for drivers: family, friends

The concept of avoidability – could this crash have been avoided?
